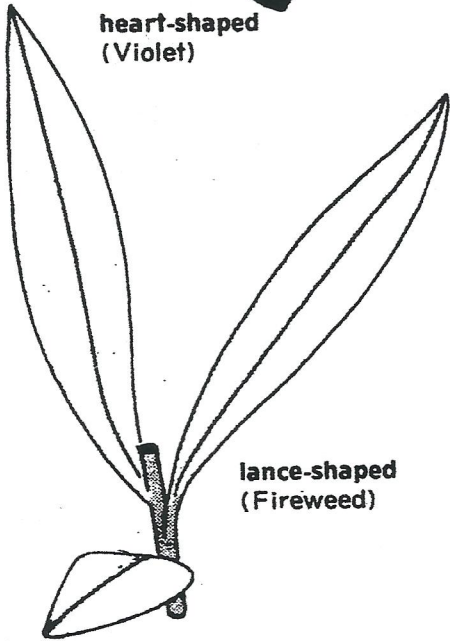

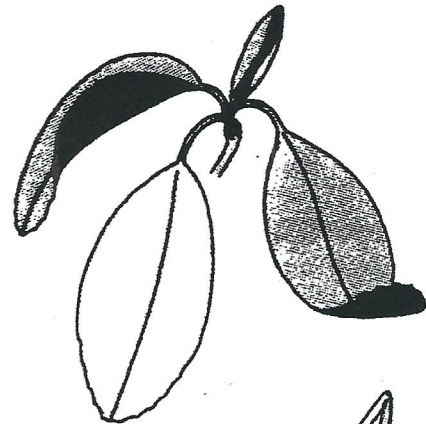

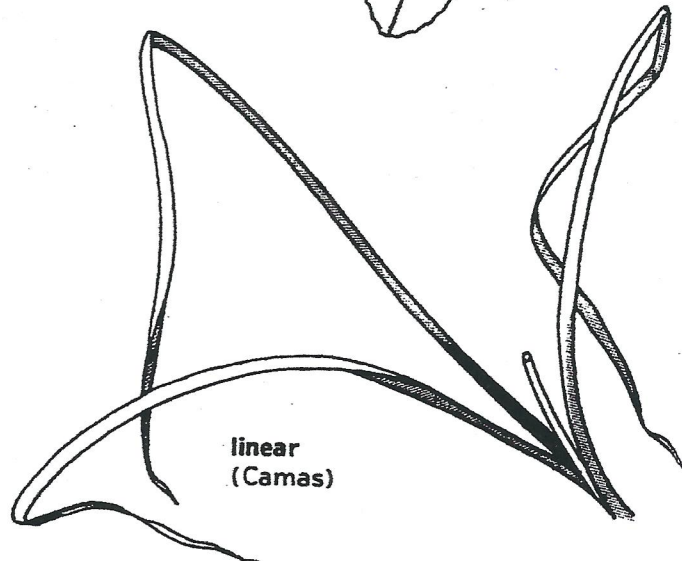

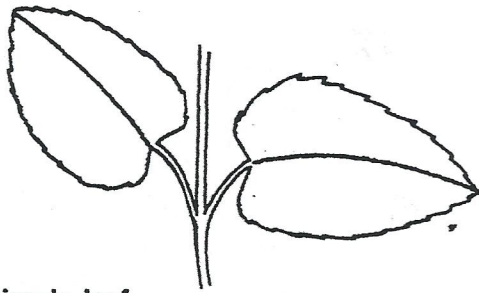

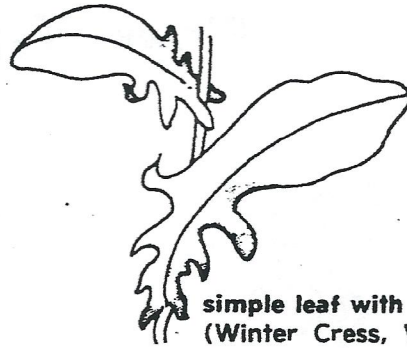

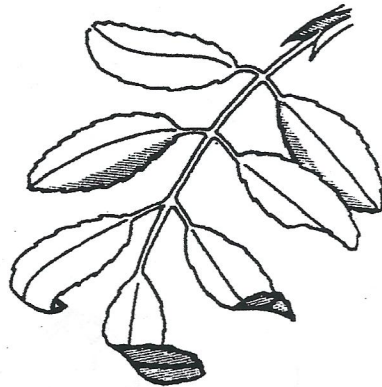

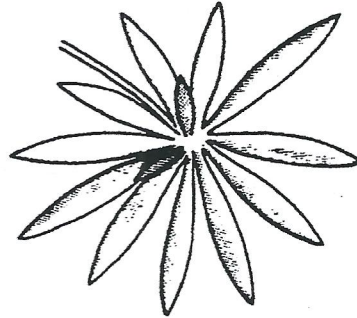
simple leaf

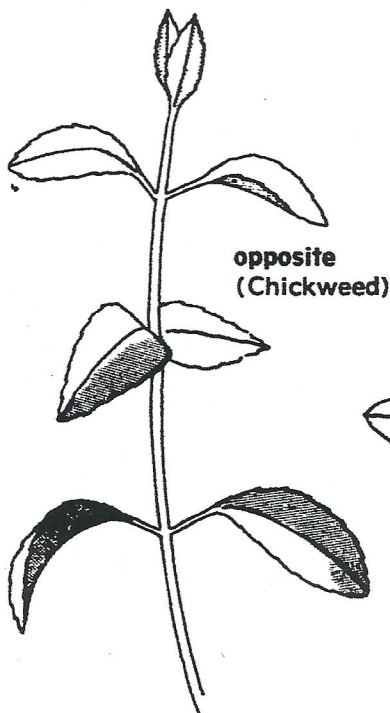
simple leaf with lateral lobes

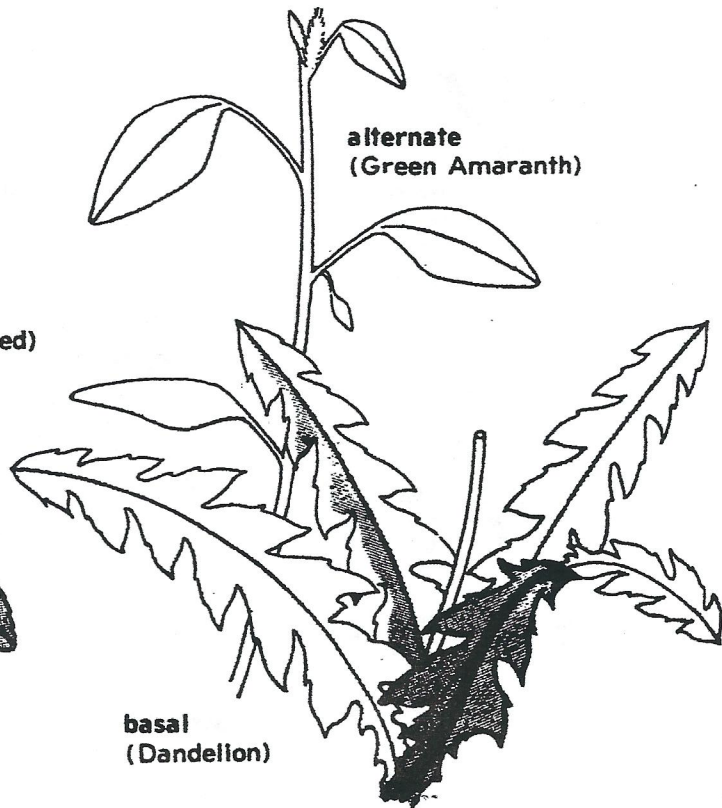
